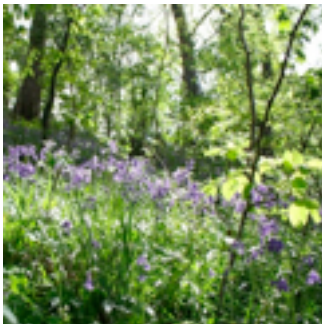
The team

The course is led by a skilled team who will bring out the best in everyone who participates. The emphasis is on learning specific skills, meeting personal challenges and growing in confidence.

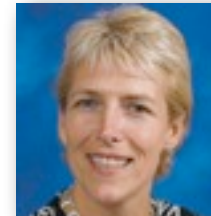
The venue
